Are bursaries available to help cover costs?

Yes. Last year NYT gave over £650,000 worth of bursaries to help participants take part in our auditions, courses and shows.

The NYT Bursary Fund is in high demand so we ask you to only apply for a bursary if you are experiencing financial hardship. They are means tested and will be offered to part cover
